

Vershire Planning Commission minutes for 3/10/21 approved

In attendance: (via Zoom) Bill Baylis-Chair, Gene Sobeck, Ken Bushey, Eleanor Zue, Bob Perkins, Debra Kingsbury-Sec'y , Sande French-Stockwell-Dev. Admin. Guest: Nicole White Fogarty

Bill called the meeting to order at 7:04pm. He asked that everyone review the agenda for tonight and the minutes from 2/17/21. The minutes were approved.

New Business: Nicole came to announce that she was running for the two year Selectboard position and shared with the Commission her background of being in education for the last 3 years and had worked for a non-profit child care program. She added that she had submitted her announcement letter in the recent town newsletter and shared her skill-set and goals for the community.

Bill stated that he had been contacted by TRORC and that Jake P. wanted to schedule a time to meet with the commission to share some "flood plain education". The group agreed to invite him to the April 14th meeting.

Old Business: Sande stated that T- Mobile's representative had submitted the commercial development application with their proposal for revisions to the cell tower off Rte 113 (on the Ulman property) to the Town Clerk's Office and that she would review it shortly.

Concerns about the pavement along Rte 113 in Vershire were discussed and how deep the three culvert repairs done between Brown Road and Richardson Road had sunk and that warning signs should be posted on both sides of the road. Bill stated that according to the project list from TRORC, the Rte 113 pavement correction is supposed to initiate this summer.
