Pavilion: Reva and Gene are still working on the budget status. Reva wants to know how much we have so we can go ahead and get the ditch taken care of.

Renovations and Projects:

Ken fixed the toilet paper holder.

Caro will sort out the sand in the 'sand box' in the playground area and continue to work on chervil in the roses.

The Town Center is a Warming (upstairs) and Cooling Center(downstairs) only. No overnight shelter will be provided. The building is only responsible for providing water and power.
