Old Business

South Vershire/Mountain Ash Cemetery:

Mark Forgarty has identified two holes and has filled them in and reseeded them, at the cost of \$200. However there are at least three more holes that need attention, including the sink hole in the Bedell plot. Rita will be in touch with him to take him to look at the other holes.

Ellis Page has agreed to complete the fence project later this summer. Rita had the lumber needed for this ordered from Foggs where the town has an account. It has been delivered to her house. So we are ready when he is.

Village Cemetery;

Clean-up from the tree removal at the Village Cemetery has not happened. Eleanor has not heard from Justin Ford.

Alleyne Howell's grave marker has sunken into the grass and needs to be elevated so that it does not disappear. Eleanor will get in touch with Kay Morton, Alleyne's widow, to see if she would like to do something about it.

Digitalizing the gravestone inscriptions at the South Vershire Cemetery and the Center Cemetery is underway. Peggy has digitalized Earl Russel's list of inscriptions of the South Vershire Cemetery but needs to check it, add the new gravestones and also devise a numbering by row that will make it easier to find graves. She is still working on digitalizing Mr. Russel's list of the Center Cemetery's inscriptions.

New business

Rita raised a question: can a lot purchaser deed his lot to someone else? can he sell it? Peggy will do some research on this.
