

**Town of Vershire Planning Commission Meeting Minutes DRAFT  
Wednesday, May 14, 2025 at 7:00 pm at the Vershire Town Center.**

**Call to Order:** G. Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm.

**Agenda Modification:** Added the report from Aaron Hoopes, Development Administrator

**Approval of Minutes:** Gregory moved that Minutes of the PC regular meeting on February 12 should be approved. Eleanor seconded the motion. The motion passed. (Note: March meeting canceled due to illness, and April meeting did not have a quorum)

**Report from Development Administrator:** Report from Aaron Hoopes, Development Officer There were two permits granted in April: One for Rosie Wawrzniak for a car port; The other was for a yurt for Derek Weiss. In May after determining the property boundaries, George Osgood was granted a permit for a sugar shack. A discussion is going on between the town and Greg Seton & Michael McIlmurray, who want to amend their permit to reflect ownership of their cabins by the non-profit company Tarpa. The Town is consulting the Town lawyer. Rod Maile was granted a permit for a carport.

**Town Plan – Update:** The Selectboard held its public hearing on the proposed Town Plan on May 6<sup>th</sup>. Minutes of the Hearing meeting are available on the town's website. Several minor changes were agreed upon, and the plan will go to the Town for a vote at the next Town Meeting. Between now and then, the Planning Commission will review the new plan's suggestions for new or amended ordinances. Most of the changes/additions would be in the Vershire Development Ordinance.

There is still the question of a noise/harassment ordinance, and how to enforce it if one is created. Discussion by the Planning Commission and Selectboard is ongoing.
