

South Vershire/Mountain Ash Cemetery gravestone locator list

Introduction

In the 1970s, Mr. Earl Russell copied the inscriptions of all the gravestones in this cemetery that existed at that time. He numbered gravestones, footstones, and even rocks, beginning with (1) at the upper right corner and ending in the lower left corner with (400). Although very accurate, this listing is difficult to use to find any particular grave.

This gravestone locator list is based on his list, reorganized into numbered rows. It includes gravestones, footstones, and new stones that have been erected since Mr. Russell made his list, but it excludes rocks, except for the doorstep of the South Vershire Free Will Baptist Church in row L13. It divides the cemetery into two halves, the Old Cemetery to the left of the driveway path, indicated by L, and the New Cemetery that was opened in 2017 to the right of the path, indicated by R. It numbers the rows from back to front, i. e., the first row of each half of the cemetery, that is Row L1 and Row R1, is along the back of the cemetery. It numbers gravestones beginning at the center driveway path, so that graves in the Old Cemetery to the left are numbered from right to left, graves in the New Cemetery to the right are numbered left to right. In the listing the initial letter, L or R, indicates the side of the cemetery, the first number indicates the row, the number after the decimal point indicates the position of the gravestone in that row. So, for example, gravestone L3.6, the grave of Gertie Douglas who died in 1872, is in the third row from the back on the left, the sixth gravestone along that row.

The first line of each entry is not part of the inscription on the stone. It begins with the location of the gravestone, followed by Mr. Russell's number enclosed in parentheses, to return the example of Gertie Douglas, (62). If the gravestone postdates Mr. Russell's listing, instead of a number in parentheses you will see (ns) meaning "new stone". The family name follows, and then perhaps a notation of the stone's condition i.e., broken, and/or mention of carving. Then it will mention if there are corner stones, markers or a footstone associated with the grave, giving Mr. Russell's number, for example Gertie Douglas's footstone (63).

The gravestone's inscription follows. / indicates a new line of the inscription, ? a best guess, and [] a comment that is not part of the inscription. Some inscriptions that Mr. Russell could decipher in the 1970s cannot now be read, either because the stone has degraded, is broken, or the ground has grown up and covered them. I have put in italics the words that Mr. Russell could read but I cannot. Very occasionally I have been able to read an inscription that Mr. Russell found illegible. Some of the gravestones that Mr. Russell enumerated no longer exist. These are included in the listing to record the existence and location of these graves, with their Russell listing numbers, but in italics and smaller type.

In the Old Cemetery, i. e., the Left side, the front of the gravestones with the primary inscriptions mostly face the woods. Some monuments also have inscriptions on the right and left sides and on the back, that is the side of the stone facing the road. To see the inscriptions in the Old Cemetery most easily, it is best to visit in the afternoon when the sun will shine on the inscriptions.

In the New Cemetery, i. e., the Right side, the inscriptions face the road.
