

Vershire Center Cemetery Listing of Grave Inscriptions and Grave Locator

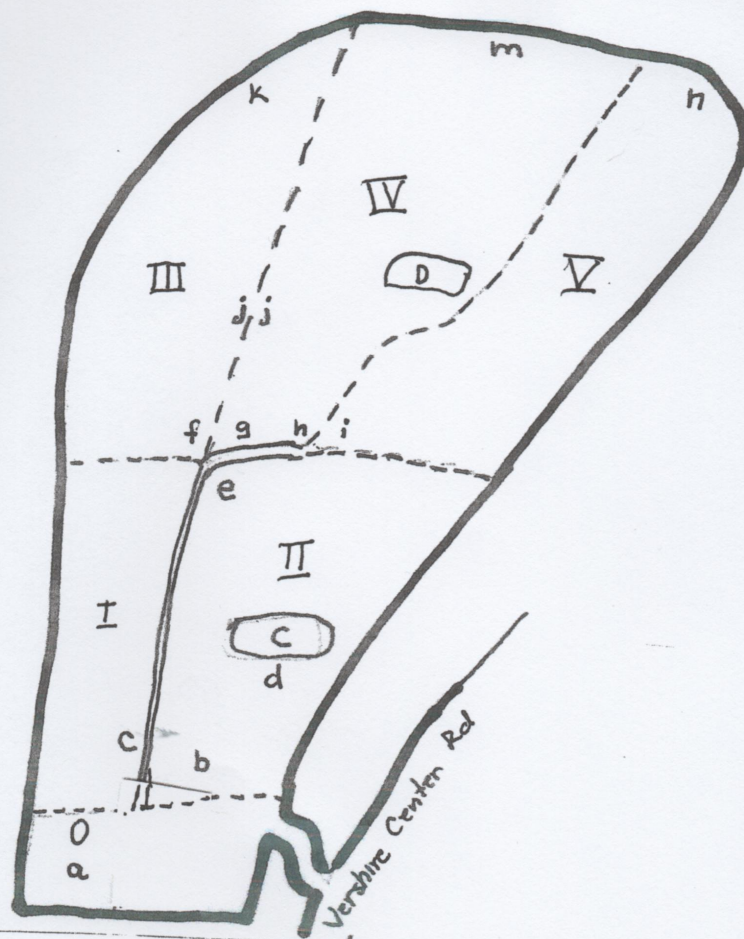
The Vershire Center Cemetery on Vershire Center Road in Vershire is closed for burials. The oldest graves date from the 1790s and the most recent from the early 20th century. On August 20, 1970 Earl Russell completed a listing of all of the stones--grave stones, footstones, and rocks-- that existed at that time. He numbered them consecutively starting at the entrance end (north), a listing that comprises 590 entries. Since the 1970s, some of the gravestones and footstones have disappeared so a new listing is needed, plus it is difficult to use the consecutive listing to locate any particular grave. This new listing, completed in October 2024 by Margaret Darrow, updates Mr. Russell's list and organizes by Sections and rows to make finding a grave easier.

This listing divides the cemetery into 6 sections, numbered 0, I, II, III, IV, V. It omits rocks and combines the footstone and the gravestone with which it is associated into one entry. Sections I and II are clearly marked out by a central path that separates the left side of the cemetery, i.e., Section I, Left, from the right side, i.e., Section II, Right. However at about midway down the cemetery this path veers to the right for a few yards and then disappears. The divisions between Sections III, IV and V are arbitrary, constructed to make it easier to find any particular grave. Section III, Back Left is divided from Section IV, Back Center by an imaginary line drawn along the original trajectory of the central path. Section IV, Back Center, is divided from Section V, Back Right, by an imaginary line extending on a diagonal from where the path ends after it jogs to the back of the cemetery. See the diagram on the following page for a visual representation of these sections.

In each section, the listing organizes the gravestones into numbered rows. This works well in Sections I and II, the north half of the cemetery. In Section 0 and Section I Left the gravestones are numbered from the right, i. e, the central path, to the left, the boundary fence. In Section II Right, the gravestones are numbered from the left, i. e., the central path, to the right, the tree line above the Vershire Center Road. Part way down Section II the stand of huge cedar trees interrupts some of the rows.

In Sections III, Back Left, the graves are numbered from the right to left, from the imaginary line to the boundary fence. Graves in Section IV Back Center are numbered from the left to right, from this line to the imaginary line extending to the woods from where the path ends after it jogs. Graves in Section V Back are also numbered from left to right, from this second imaginary line to the tree line above the road. Unfortunately in this, the south end of the cemetery, the gravestones are sometimes not well aligned in rows. When this is the case the listing will have notations to help you find the grave you are looking for.

Vershire Center Cemetery Listing of grave inscriptions.

Organization of graves: I divided the cemetery into 6 sections--see the diagram. I have divided each section into rows of gravestones numbered from the north end (the entry) to the south. Graves within each row in sections 0, I, III & IV are numbered from right to left, i.e., from the center to the fence; graves in sections II and V are numbered from left to right, i.e., from the center to the woods along the road.

Entries: The first letter indicates the section: L for Section I Left; R for Section II Right; BL for Section III Back Left; BC for Section IV Back Center; BR for Section V Back Right. It is followed by the row number and, after the decimal point, the number of the grave in that row.

Numbers in () are from Earl Russell's transcript of August 20, 1970.

The first line of each entry is not part of the inscription; it is the family name, a notation of carving if any exists, and associated footstone if any exists. It may also comment on the condition of the stone, for example, broken, or illegible.

The second line of each entry begins the inscription on the gravestone. A slash / indicates a new line in the inscription. [] indicates a comment for example [right] to indicate an inscription on the right side of a stone. [?] indicates a best guess of an inscription that is difficult to read. Ellipsis . . . indicates an illegible line. *Italics* indicate a stone or an inscription recorded by Mr. Russell but now missing.
