Vershire Town Center Committee Meeting Notes

Attendees: Reva Seybolt. Ken Bushey, Nicole White-Fogarty, Caro Bick

Ken moved to approve the amended minutes from September, Nicole seconded the motion.

Select Board: Nicole is taking care of the light bulbs and Vern is having a permanent grate put on the lower part of the Pizza Oven so there will be no more fires built under there.

Rec Committee: Ken is in the process of redefining the Mission Statement to include activities on ALL town properties.

Kathy is still working on The trail. Ken will talk to Kathy about the cement slabs and getting them moved. Nicole suggested the road crew could use them at the new Town Garage. The Santa Party is good to go on December 6 from 2:00-4:00. Santa will make an appearance half way through the party, greet the kids and then be done so he doesn't have to sit around all alone for so long.

Ken will bring in the hoses now and after the rink is filled which also will happen that same weekend. He might also take on the task of figuring out a cover for the hole the Christmas tree goes in.

Vershare: Reva reported on the Food Share using the info prepared for VerShare for their annual fundraising letter.

Vershire Historical Society: They will light the Christmas Tree on December 6th at four PM. There was going to be a tour of the old Vershire Town Center Site at the Mountain School's Fall Festival but the schedule was messed up and it was cancelled.

There has been an anonymous grant awarded to repair the old slaughter house.

Renovations and projects: Caro is going to use wood putty and repaint the old sign this winter. Caro has ordered one pair of curtains for the Town Center to make sure the quality is good enough and that they will work.

Budget for 2026-2027:

Reva will check on the cost of moving the hot water heater and plumbing and also rehabbing the closet. She will see where Uriah stands as far as working on projects such as Painting and the closet project.

Nicole thinks the wood chips will cost around \$5,000

The sand for the playground will be free.

Caro will do the sign repair and painting for free.

Gene will have the info on the carpet cleaning company and Reva will get that from him.

Caro will get bids on the cupola from Erik Grote and Martin Ward and any other carpenters she can drum up.

The first aid kit was found and now sits in the kitchen.

The AED (Defibrillator) needs new pads, so Reva will ask Pat Barnes, who is in charge of the maintenance on the machine to look into that.

Reva will ask Larry Lancaster about the Vershire Farmer's Market tents and garbage cans.
