

Vershire Village Listing of Gravestone Inscriptions and Grave Locator

The Vershire Village Cemetery is on the North Road up the side of the hill behind the Vershire Bible Church. It has few if any burial plots available for purchase although burials continue in already established family plots. The oldest graves date from the early 19th century, for example, that of Mary E. Summer, wife of Horace Mattoon, who died in 1815, (L10.8 in the listing.) Gary Goodrich and Margaret Darrow each compiled lists of inscriptions. This listing combines their efforts as of 2025. It will need to be updated as gradually gravestones are added.

You may reach the cemetery from a driveway that runs behind the church along the bottom of the cemetery and then swings to the left to go up the hill, dividing the cemetery in half. These halves are identified in the listing as Left and Right, the L or R that heads each entry. Next in the entry is the number of the row in which the grave stone is located, counting from the bottom of the hill to the top. Then follows the number of the stone within that row counting in from the driveway, and the family name. It may also include a description of the stone and if there is a footstone. For example, the grave of Betsy Fletcher identified as "L3.4 Fletcher. fallen-over--footstone" means that it is on the left side of the driveway in the third row from the bottom, the fourth stone to the left of the driveway, that the stone has fallen over and a footstone accompanies it.

The second line of each entry begins the inscription on the gravestone. A slash / indicates a new line in the inscription. [] indicates a comment, for example [right] to indicate an inscription on the right side of a stone. (?) indicates a best guess of an inscription that is difficult to read. -- indicates an illegible word or line.

Part I of the listing is the oldest section of the cemetery on the lower left behind the church. The graves here date mostly from the second half of the 19th century. We have counted the rows starting at the bottom of the cemetery and going on up the hill. Graves are numbered from right to left, beginning at the driveway and ending at the band of trees along the side of the cemetery above route 113. There are 21 rows in this section which ends about halfway up the hill where a slight depression and empty space separate it from Part II.

Part II is the newer section going on up the hill behind Part I on the left of the driveway. The row numbers continue, i.e., the first row of this section is L22; the last is L36 along the back fence. The graves here are from the 20th and 21st centuries.

Part III is to the right of the driveway. Once again the rows are numbered from the bottom to the top, although here the bottom is partway up the hill. The grave of little Lyle Abar is on its own, just to the right of the driveway against the fence, indicated on the listing as Row R0.1 There are 18 rows of graves on this side of the driveway, with the graves numbered from left to right, that is from the driveway to the fence. There are a few graves from the 19th century but most are from the 20th and 21st centuries.
